The Judo Club must be affiliated and recognised by one National Judo Federation member in the EJU, must have at least one certified Trainer of Mediators and five certified Judo Mediators of Jita Kyoie Ethics & Values.

04

To obtain the EJU Club Quality Label certification, club managers must complete the requirements through the Label Attribution platform. This includes providing detailed information about the club's facilities, services, and programs. Once all requirements are met, the certification can be submitted to the national federations for approval.

05

Upon successful submission and certification of the club, the club will be awarded with:

1. EJU Clubs Quality Label Certification Diploma
2. EJU Diploma for Trainer of Mediators and Judo Mediators of Jita Kyoei Ethics & Values
3. EJU Jita Kyoei Ethics & Values Flag for the Dojo
4. EJU Jita Kyoei Ethics & Values posters
